20 May 2009	Examination Attendance Dockets will be despatched by the Hong Kong Examinations and Assessment Authority to all candidates.	Upon receipt of the Examination Attendance Docket, candidates must check all details on the document. If any of the data is incorrect, candidates should contact the HKIAAT <u>IMMEDIATELY</u> .	Changes in examination centres will not be entertained.
25 May 2009		Candidates who have not received their Examination Attendance Docket or have misplaced it should contact the HKIAAT <u>IMMEDIATELY</u> for a duplicate copy.	At least two working days should be allowed to process a duplicate copy of the Examination Attendance Docket. Candidates are strongly advised <u>NOT</u> to leave such an application until the last minute.
From 29 May 2009 to date of examination		Candidates who have not yet received a duplicate copy of their Examination Attendance Docket should check with the HKIAAT <u>IMMEDIATELY</u> to establish their examination centre.
