The Accounting and Business Management Case Competition 2013-14 Result announcement of Tertiary institute Group



In its 12th year, the HKIAAT Accounting and Business Management Case Competition have received 177 entries with over 650 students from Hong Kong and Mainland joining.

This annual event allows students to apply their textbook knowledge in the areas of accounting and business to the real commercial world. It also enhances students' soft skills such as analytical skills, time management, presentation skills, creativity and team building throughout the competition in order to win a prize.

Pak Fah Yeow International Limited is the company selected for this year's case study. Participating teams, comprises three to four members, are required to submit a written business proposal to analyze Pak Fah Yeow's business performance and to give recommendation on strategies to sustain the company's growth. Based on the business proposals, the reviewers shortlisted, through a blind review, the best six teams to enter the final round of the Competition – the oral presentation which was successfully held on 29 March 2014 – to compete for the Championship.

During the oral presentation, each team had 15 minutes to present their business proposal before the judging panel and followed by 5-minute Q&A session to respond to judges' queries. Finally, after a hard time in selection, the results of this year's competition were out:
