Membership and Studentship Renewal for 2012

Annual membership and studentship fees will be due soon. Members and students will receive their renewal package in early December 2011. There is no increase in fees, that is, AAT membership fee is HK\$700, while the student fee of AAT examination is HK\$600. PBE students are required to pay a student fee of HK\$700 which will be waived provided that they maintain an uninterrupted membership with HKIAAT. These fees will be due on 2 January 2012. All members and students are obliged to pay the annual fees before the due date. The 2012 renewal packages with subscription payment advice, annual update form and CPD Declaration Form (for members only) will be posted to your last known correspondence address in early December 2011.

Fees for re-instating membership or studentship

Delay or failure to settle the fees will result in the removal of the member's or student's name from the Member or Student Register and hence cause a lapse of membership or studentship status with HKIAAT. In order to have their status re-instated, members or students whose names are removed must pay a re-registration fee. Furthermore, students who are removed from the Register are required to pay the prevailing fees again should they wish to claim back the exemptions previously granted or the examination results previously awarded. Therefore settling the annual subscription on time is important.

CPD requirements

Members are further reminded that they are required to comply with a minimum of 20 hours of unstructured CPD per year for renewal of membership.
