If any of the data is incorrect, students should contact the HKIAAT IMMEDIATELY.</p> <p>SCRIPT REPORT SERVICE If a student wishes to have a written report on his/her performance, he/she should make a <u>written application within two weeks</u> from the date of announcement of the results and send this, together with the payment of a non-refundable fee of \$680 per paper, to the HKIAAT.</p> <p>Verbal, late or incomplete applications will not be accepted.</p>	<p>The HKIAAT will NOT deal with enquiries about the examination results.</p> <p>Students should note that the script report service is NOT a re-marking exercise. It is purely an exercise to let the student know his/her performance in the examination.</p>
