Chapter objectives	Learning outcomes are specified at the start of each chapter to help students navigate their way through the syllabus.
Learning objective markers	These markers indicate milestones that correspond to the chapter objectives to facilitate successful learning.
Examples	Short examples are used throughout each chapter to illustrate key points and concepts.
Key points	These are designed to focus students' attention on important areas.
Chapter review	Written in point form and frequently using diagrams to aid comprehension, the summary helps students to sum up what they have learnt in each chapter, and thus assimilate the material better.
What you need to know	Key definitions are reinforced at the end of each chapter.
Work them out	These end-of-chapter questions allow students to practice and apply what they have learnt. The mixture of multiple-choice, short-answer and essay-type questions are designed to gear students up for the examinations.
Answers	Suggested answers to the "Work them out" questions enable students to check that they have understood what they have learnt.
Pilot paper	A pilot exam paper (comprising questions and suggested answers) is included at the back of each study text to help students test themselves and get used to the format of the examination paper.
Index	This provides an easy search for key words in each study text.
