I attempted this paper by self-study. Effective time management is a crucial factor for a self-study student. Unlike attending preparatory course which has a fixed schedule, the progress of self-study is very flexible, depending on your own pace of study. Meanwhile, you have to decide how frequent and how much to read (e.g. 10 to 15 pages each week). To consolidate what you had learned before, I think it is quite helpful that you spend a few minutes to scan the previous few pages before you start reading new pages. Also, you should understand what you had already learned before you continue to read the next paragraph.

Finally, you should ensure that you have sufficient time to prepare for the examination after you had read the study text thoroughly.
