### ***Thoughts from Mr. Lam:***

In my view, preparation and good time management are the most important factors in passing the examination.

My preparation is divided into two phases: study and revision. A three-month study plan is set and I usually spend about one week on each topic. When we study the examination materials, we should make our own notes to ensure thorough understanding of the contents and important points. For me, colour pen is a useful tool! The technical articles published in HKIAAT quarterly journal T/Dialogue are also a valuable source of reference materials. Practising past examination papers and reading the examiners' reports can help you learn good answering techniques and avoid making common mistakes. One week before the examination is the revision period. We can study our own notes and practise specific questions in the textbook and past examination papers intensively.

During the examination, time management is critical. First of all, I will glance through the entire question paper. Then I will answer the easy questions first. Try not to exceed the allowed time for each question. If you do this, you can answer all the questions and your efforts will not be wasted.
